**Scarborough Fire Station**

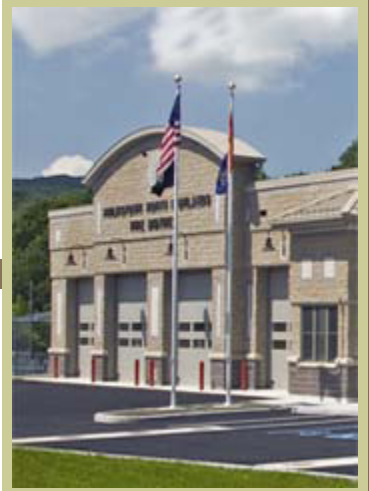

**Meeting the Rising Cost of Energy: Why Green Buildings?**

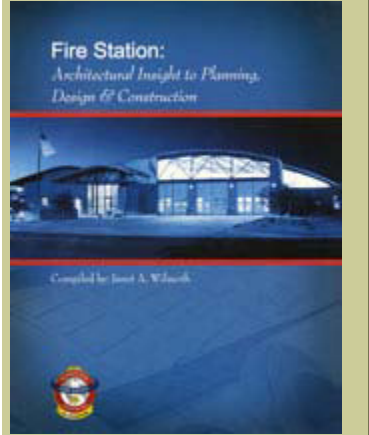
