The lecture will describe methodologies to assess the distribution of your department's resources relative to demand and the facility's capabilities, in light of modern standards, and thus determine the most appropriate location for your fire station(s).

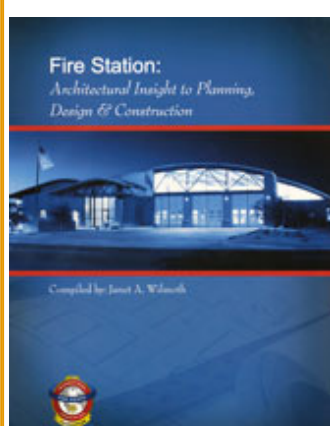
